COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this 8-week micro-credential, you will be introduced to Egan's Skilled Helper Model, which is used as a framework and practical structure to apply and deepen your helping conversations with others. You will explore how it integrates with the Relational Skills Model.

Furthermore, gain a deeper understanding of how to work with clients who are resistant, challenging, or diverse, while exploring the ethical considerations and the role of responsibility and accountability in the helping relationship.

- Week 6: Ethical decision-making and working ethically and within your skillset.
- Week 7: Review and application.
- Week 8: Conclusion and summative project.

By the end of this course you will be able to:

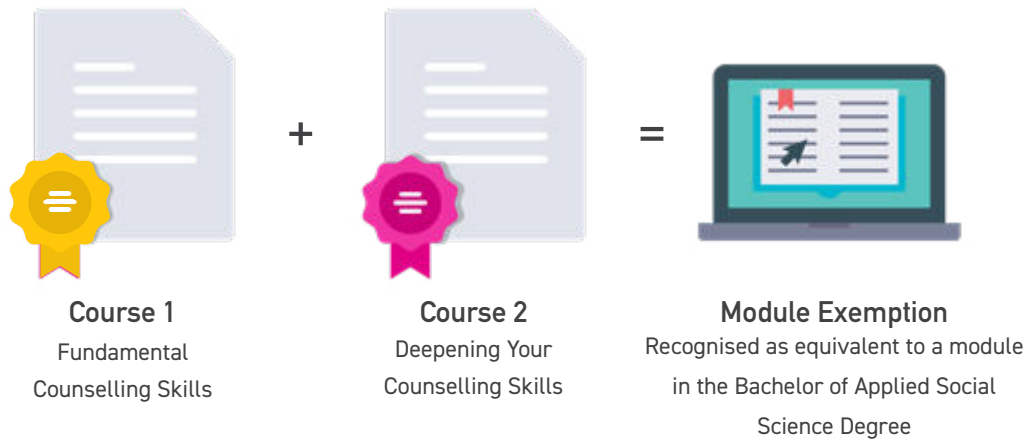
- Demonstrate self-reflective evaluation of creating an environment conducive to holding a helping conversation.

Learners create a portfolio of work that demonstrate their newfound knowledge and skills.

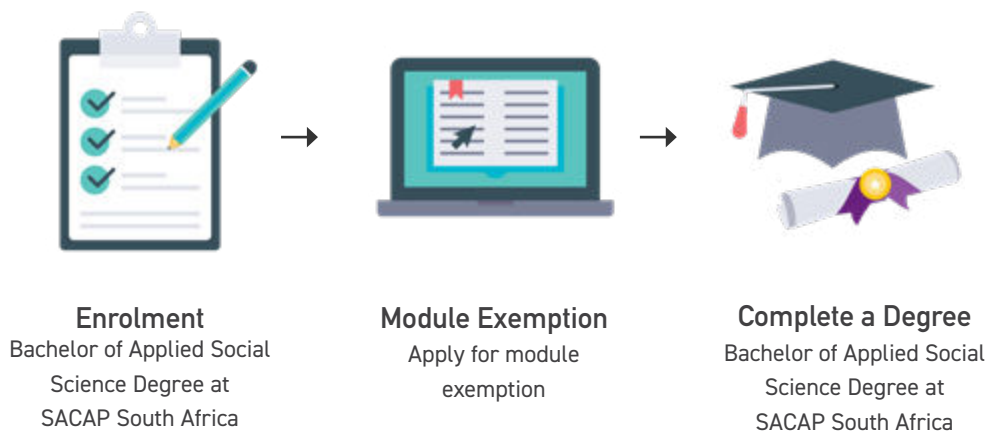
